

Facilities Associate

Mission: The core mission of the Facilities associate is to advance the mission and vision of SAMBICA to *inspire youth to a relationship with Jesus Christ* through serving our guests and ensuring that they have an excellent experience on our grounds.

Specifics: Assist the Facilities Manager in the care, maintenance, and improvement of all structures, equipment, and facility related systems on SAMBICA property. Depending on skills and interest, take ownership of an area of facilities maintenance and advancement.

Associates Program: SAMBICA Associates are career-ready young adults looking to begin their career in a ministry setting. It is envisioned as a two-year program during which time Associates will invest in SAMBICA while SAMBICA is also investing in them through mentoring, exploration of calling, volunteer opportunities, and the building up of their community both inside and outside of SAMBICA. This is a full-time commitment with salary and benefits provided. Associates will focus in a specific area while also spending 20% of their time supporting other areas of camp.
